

TRAVEL TEAM EXPECTATIONS:

BSC age requirements 8/1/87 – 7/31/98 Separate boys & girls

1. Each coach will determine cancellation of practice for weather reasons.
2. The team coaches will determine cancellation of games. All cancellations must be communicated immediately to the referee assignor or we pay the referees anyway.
3. Playing time will be at the coach's discretion. Any problems or questions about the Travel program should be directed to the program coordinator, Mickey Goldwasser, 589-7493.
4. Rude language and unsportsman like conduct is not acceptable by coaches, players or parents. The Bristol Soccer Club strives to maintain the family atmosphere for all participants and fans. Poor behavior can be grounds for expulsion from participation in the league and is a "red card" offense. The BSC disciplinary committee will review any red card ejections. The Board of Directors and the CJSA can take further actions at that time.
5. We encourage each player to bring water to the practices and make sure they replace lost water from game play. The concession stand should be open for Home games.
6. No jewelry, watches, rings, etc., are allowed by any player. This rule is enforced to prevent injury to players and opponents. Safety Glasses are recommended for players that require eyeglasses.
7. It is expected that each player will bring a ball to the practices. Each player will wear a team uniform to each game. Shin guards are required for participation at all levels of play.
8. Players are required to purchase uniforms prior to participation. A uniform replacement rotation is in effect; your coach will know the specifics of when your team is due to purchase uniforms.
9. Coaches will receive equipment for their individual teams. We ask the coach to bring that to each of the practices and games. It is expected that the equipment will be returned to the Bristol Soccer Club at the end of the season.
10. Every Parent is expected to help on the day or days their team is responsible for the concession stand. This is an essential part of parental support of the program. Travel parents are key to concession stand success.
11. No spectators behind goals or on team benches. All spectators must sit on the sidelines opposite team benches.
